# Troparion and Kontakion

## Tone 7 Troparion (Resurrection)

By Thy <u>Cross</u> Thou didst destroy <u>death</u>. To the thief Thou didst open <u>Par</u>adise. For the <u>Myrrh</u>bearers Thou didst change weeping into <u>joy</u>, and Thou didst command Thy disciples, O <u>Christ</u> God, to pro<u>claim</u> that Thou art <u>risen</u>,// granting the <u>world</u> great <u>mer</u>cy.

## Tone 1 Troparion (Mary Magdalene)

By <u>keeping</u> His commandments and laws, holy Mary <u>Mag</u>dalene, thou didst follow Christ, Who for our sake was born of the <u>Virgin</u>, and in <u>cel</u>ebrating thy most holy <u>mem</u>ory today,// we receive forgiveness of <u>sins</u> by thy prayers.

#### Tone 4 Troparion (Hieromartyr Phocas)

By sharing in the ways of the A<u>pos</u>tles, thou didst become a suc<u>ces</u>sor to their throne. Through the practice of virtue, thou didst find the way to divine contemplation, O in<u>spired</u> one of God; by teaching the word of Truth without error, thou didst defend the Faith, even to the <u>shed</u>ding of thy blood.// Hieromartyr Phocas, entreat Christ God to <u>save</u> our souls!

## Tone 7 Kontakion (Resurrection)

The do<u>min</u>ion of death can no longer hold men <u>cap</u>tive, for Christ descended, shattering and destroying its <u>powers</u>. Hell is <u>bound</u>, while the Prophets rejoice and cry: "The Savior has come to <u>those</u> in faith;// enter, you <u>faithful</u>, into the Resur<u>rec</u>tion!"

## Tone 3 Kontakion (Mary Magdalene)

Standing be<u>fore</u> the Cross of the <u>Sav</u>ior, suffering with the <u>Moth</u>er of the Lord, the most <u>glo</u>rious Mary <u>Mag</u>dalene didst offer <u>praise</u> with tears. She cried out: "What is this strange <u>won</u>der? He Who <u>holds</u> the whole creation in His hand chooses to <u>suffer.// Glo</u>ry to Thy <u>pow</u>er, O Lord!"

#### Tone 2 Kontakion (Hieromartyr Phocas)

The <u>Mas</u>ter established thee as a <u>bril</u>liant sun, shining on all the faithful, glorious O hieromartyr <u>Pho</u>cas. He accepted thy <u>life</u>, faith, and contest as myrrh,// for He is rich in mercy.

# **Epistle and Gospel Readings**

## Epistle: I Corinthians 1:10-18

<sup>10</sup> Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. 11 For it has been declared to me concerning you, my brethren, by those of Chloe's household, that there are contentions among you. 12 Now I say this, that each of you says, "I am of Paul," or "I am of Apollos," or "I am of Cephas," or "I am of Christ." 13 Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? 14 I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius, 15 lest anyone should say that I had baptized in my own name. 16 Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas. Besides, I do not know whether I baptized any other. 17 For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel, not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of no effect. <sup>18</sup> For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

## Epistle: Matthew 14:14-22

<sup>14</sup> And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick. <sup>15</sup> When it was evening, His disciples came to Him, saying, "This is a deserted place, and the hour is already late. Send the multitudes away, that they may go into the villages and buy themselves food." <sup>16</sup> But Jesus said to them, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat." <sup>17</sup> And they said to Him, "We have here only five loaves and two fish." <sup>18</sup> He said, "Bring them here to Me." <sup>19</sup> Then He commanded the multitudes to sit down on the grass. And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves

to the disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitudes. <sup>20</sup>So they all ate and were filled, and they took up twelve baskets full of the fragments that remained. <sup>21</sup>Now those who had eaten were about five thousand men, besides women and children. <sup>22</sup>Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, while He sent the multitudes away.
