

Dear Faithful, Christ is in our Midst!

In the May newsletter, we reflected on how our faith in Jesus Christ manifests itself in acts of faithfulness at home and in our local community of the Body of Christ. Stewardship is simply being faithful to what God has given us.

The concept of being a faithful steward needs to be reframed. In our times, we reduce stewardship to a list of duties we are obligated to perform to be well with God. In my Protestant years, I heard more than one sermon suggesting that if I did not tithe, God would not protect me, just as a mob boss does not protect those who do not pay their dues. This way of thinking reduces our relationship with God to either seeking reward or avoiding punishment. Believe it or not, the Christian life is not about seeking reward or avoiding punishment. The Christian life is about being restored and made whole by God's grace. When God created humans, He gave them a priestly vocation. A biblical priest receives what is given and offers it to God in thanksgiving. Adam and Eve were placed in paradise to tend the garden and offer it back to God in an act of worship. Everything in our life is a gift from God. The food we eat, the air we breathe, the clothing we wear, and the community we exist in, are all gifts from God. When we offer what God has given us in gratitude, an exchange of life happens. We offer our earthly material existence to God, and God gives us His divine life in return.

There are three simple truths related to our priestly calling.

- Everything we have in our life is from God.
- If we offer what we have been given in our lives in thanksgiving, a divine exchange takes place.
- In the divine exchange, we are healed, made whole, and grow toward what we were created to be.

In this light, Christia stewardship is a calling that results in us growing closer to God.

Here are some questions to reflect on this month: Do I believe that everything in my life somehow comes from the hand of God? Am I thankful for the gifts that God has bestowed on me? In what ways can I offer myself to God? Do I want to grow in Christ? As you reflect and pray, I would love to hear your thoughts.
