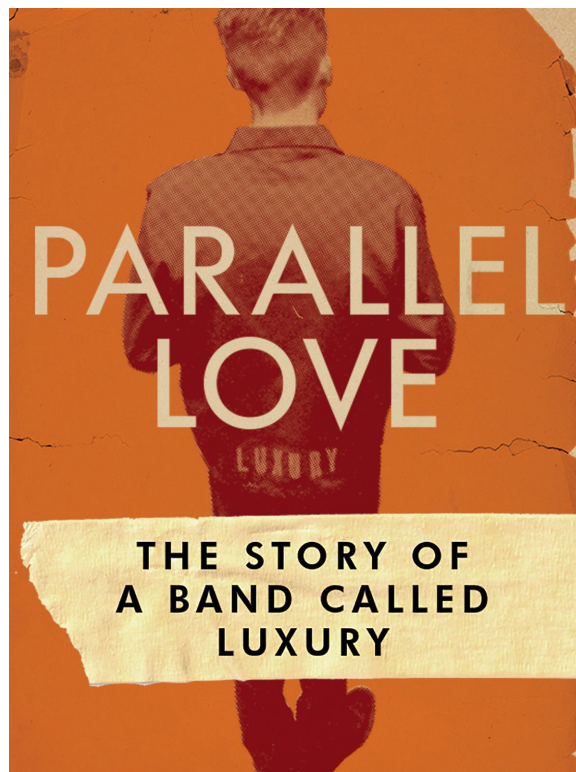

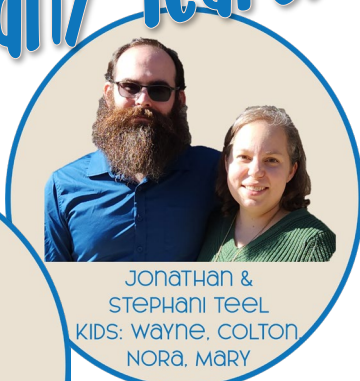

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATE



December Meeting Highlights

Our Meeting in December was on Saturday, December 13th at 11:00 am

- We finalized the budget for 2026, Nominations Report, and Annual Parish Meeting Agenda.
- We discussed our Charity Distributions for and determined the remainder of the 2025 budget would be paid to the Monroe Crisis Pregnancy Center for Local and an Alaskan Parish for National. Jordan will reach out to Saint Innocent in Napakiak, AK.
- We discussed the potential surplus for 2025 and where we would like to allocate those funds. We will be setting aside money for our 30th Anniversary, Iconography, Strategic Planning, and Expansion / Missionization.
- In looking at the budget for 2026, it was discovered that Father's pay was not calculated correctly part of the surplus will be used to correct Father's 2025 pay.
- We discussed Cemetery Lawncare and how much would be owed to the church by the cemetery for 2025
- In discussing the Cemetery, we also reviewed the Cemetery Regulations specifically in regard to non-Orthodox family members. Article III, Section d speaks directly to this point and states "Persons eligible for the purchase and assignment of a Certificate of Easement and Use for Burial of Remains in Saint Innocent Orthodox Christian Cemetery also include all those who are close family members, i.e., parents, siblings, spouses, or children, of those falling within the terms and provisions of Article III, Sections (a) and (b) above, but who are themselves not united to the Orthodox Church, but who for exigent pastoral cause, in the sole discretion of the Parish Priest and the Parish Council, may appropriately be buried in Saint Innocent Orthodox Christian Cemetery."
- We also discussed the candle stubs and how we wanted to handle them. There are two 5 gallon buckets needing to be emptied. It was decided the best course of action would be to bury them in a hole at the back of the property.
- We discussed the upcoming Ministry Fair and when and how would be the best way to accomplish our goal. There are roles that need to be filled and ministries that need to have more hands. We do not want to be only 1 person deep in any ministry area of the parish.
- We also took a look at the current resolution with the bank and made changes to who will be authorized to do business on behalf of the church with the bank and who will be check signers. Sarah will draft a new resolution to have on file with the bank.

Our next meeting is scheduled for January 17th @ 3:00 pm
